



MY FIRST CAR

I have been driving for 50 years and in that time I have owned 29 cars although I have to confess that five have been company vehicles. However, most of them were driven for longer than many of the cars I have purchased with my own hard earned cash. In 1970 I passed my driving test and, having just started my first permanent job, my thoughts turned to buying a car. At that time the choice was mainly British and, after scouring the Bristol Evening Post for a suitable vehicle within my budget of £120, I found a 1961 Ford Anglia, a deluxe model with a heater in Imperial Maroon with a grey roof.

A deal was done and there then followed 18 months enjoying its' 997cc to the full. I'm sure the speedo was somewhat optimistic as I saw 90 on a stretch of the M4 one afternoon. However, it was not trouble free as I recollect driving back to Bristol from Exeter with no foot brake and on one occasion breaking down on the A38 with a burnt out clutch. I was able to catch the last train home though, returning the following day to arrange for repairs. The joys of motoring in the early 1970 without AA membership! Mechanical problems aside, my Ford eventually succumbed to the dreaded tin worm and was sold for £25 to a distant family member for parts.
